Examples of UNACCEPTABLE Internet/Intranet Use

1. Using the network for any illegal activity, including violation of copyright or other contracts or licensing agreements;
2. Using the network for personal financial or commercial gain;
3. Degrading or disrupting equipment or system performance; tampering with the equipment;
4. Vandalizing the data of another user;
5. Gaining unauthorized access to resources or entities;
6. Invading the privacy of individuals;
7. Using the password of another user or giving out your password;
8. Posting another person's personal communications without the author's consent;
9. Posting anonymous messages;
10. Sending out division/department communications which have not completed the KSBE review/approval process as though they were official documents of KSBE, or using the KSBE seal and name without following the internal review/approval procedures;
11. Swearing, using vulgarities or any other inappropriate language;
12. Sending "mailbombs" (huge files designed to clog another user's mailbox), flaming or taking retaliatory action against another user on the internet;
13. Posting or e-mailing chain letters;
14. Posting many copies of the same message to many individuals or newsgroups.
