(CD & DVD Burning Software for Macs)

Burning CDs with Toast 5 Titanium (Mac)

Toast 5 Titanium is a software program that enables you to burn CDs and DVDs to store all of your digital content. You will be able to preserve and share your data with others in no time.


* Prerequisite: Toast 5 Titanium should already be installed onto your computer (Mac only). You should also have a CD-R or CD-RW.

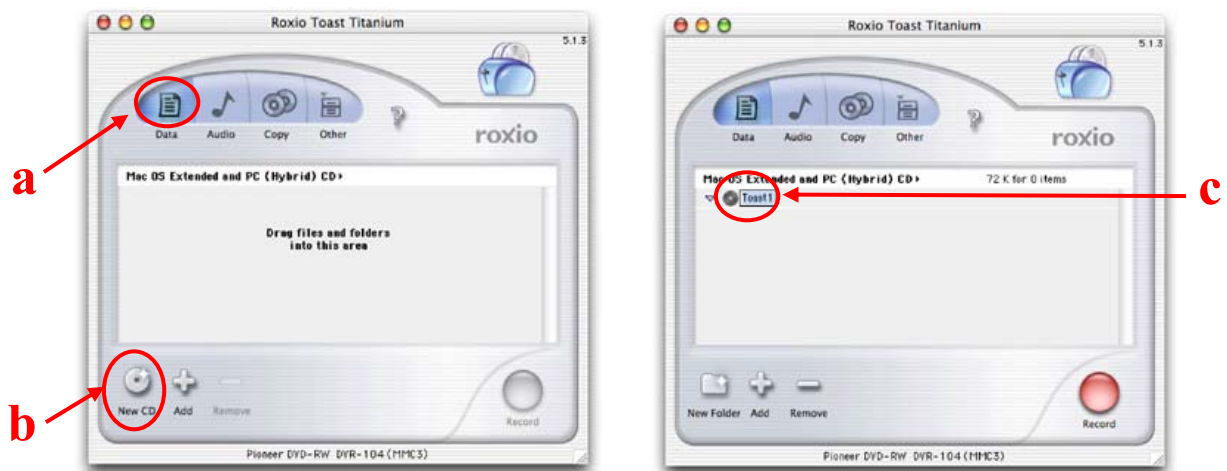
Burning a Blank CD

 Do not place your CD into the drive yet. If you do, the Macintosh default burner program will launch (not Toast). If this occurs, select “Ignore” when prompted to prepare your CD.


1. Launch Toast by double clicking the toast icon on the desktop (or by locating it on the hard drive in the application folder).

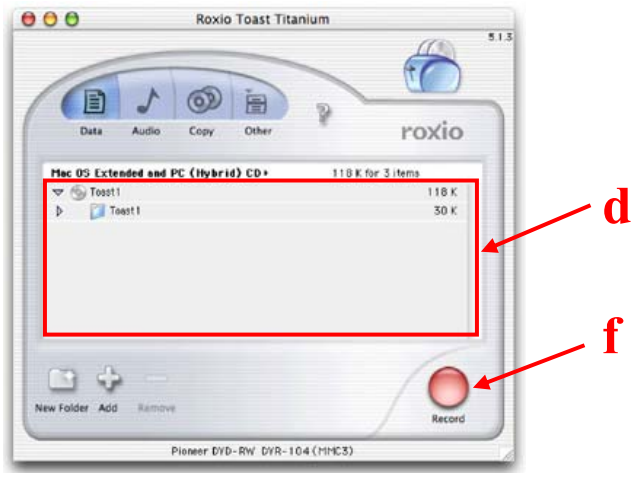


2. Prepare data for burning:
 - a. Click on the **Data** tab to burn a data CD.
 - b. Click on **New CD** to burn a new session (Each time you are burning files, you are creating a new session on your CD).
 - c. Click on **Untitled CD** and give your session a name.



- d. Drag files to be recorded into the data window.
- e. Insert your blank CD into the recordable CD drive (use the eject button located on the upper right corner of your keyboard).
- f. Click on the **Record** button to begin burning your files to CD.

 It would probably be easier to drag files if you display it on the desktop before dragging.

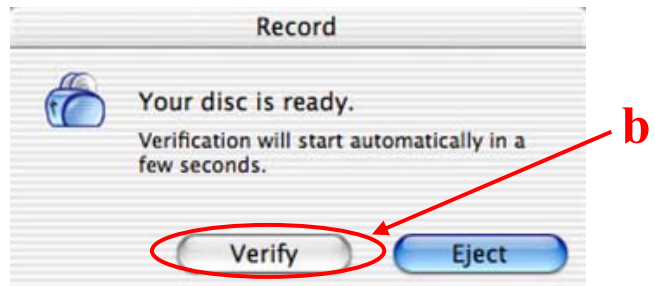


3. Record data onto CD:

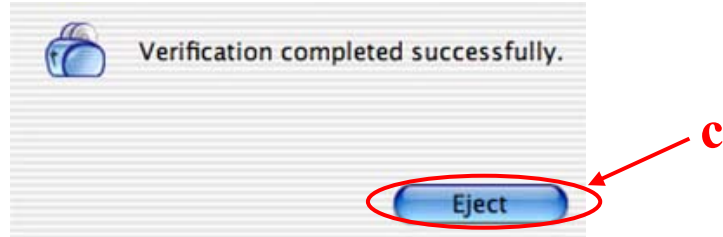
- a. Click on **Write Session** to record your first session (Click on **Write Disc only** if you are certain that you will not be burning any more sessions onto the CD).



- b. When prompted, click on **Verify** (or wait a little while and verification will start automatically).

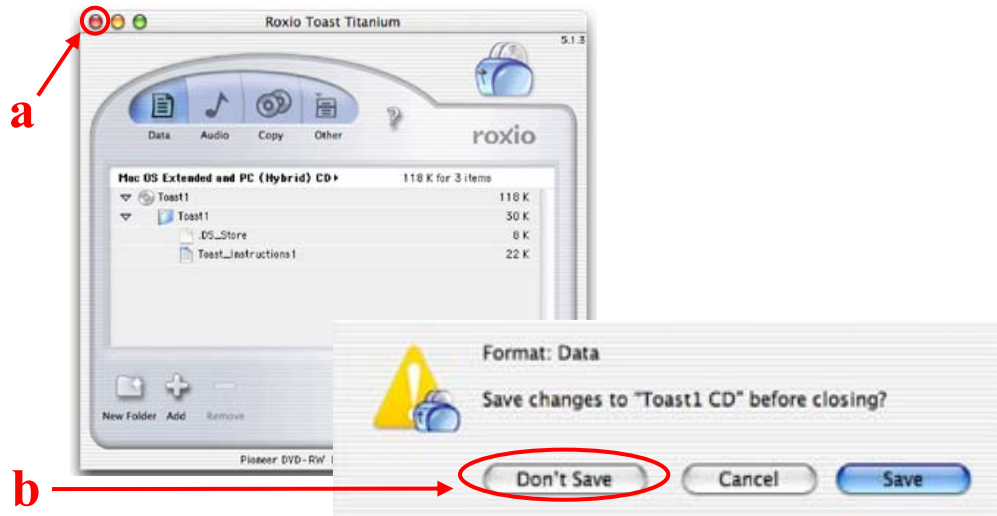


- c. Click on **Eject** to eject the CD.



4. Exit Toast application:

- a. Click on the **Close** button or select **Toast** from the menu bar and click on **Quit Toast**.
- b. When prompted to save, click on **Don't Save**.



5. View data on CD:

- a. Insert CD into drive to confirm that you have recorded your data properly.



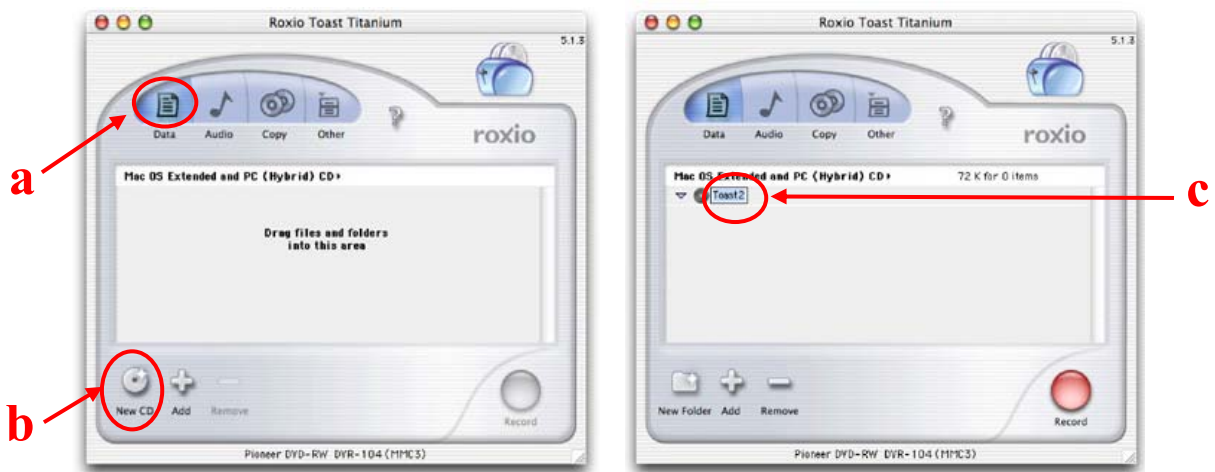
Burning a Multi-Session CD

* Follow these instructions if you are burning on a CD that already has sessions on it and would like to add another session to the CD.

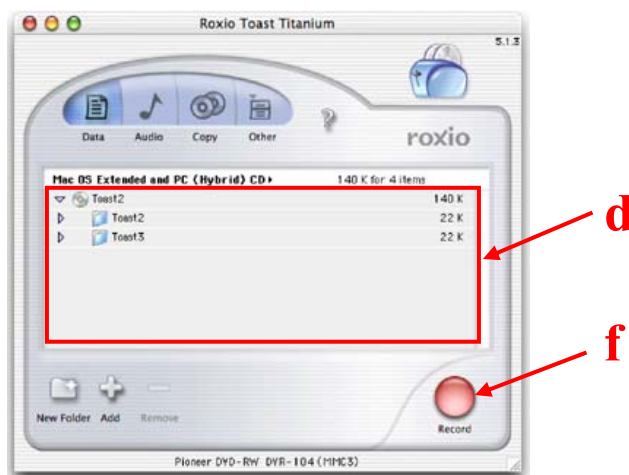
1. Launch Toast by double clicking the toast icon on the desktop (or by locating it on the hard drive in the application folder.



2. Prepare data for burning:
 - a. Click on the **Data** tab to burn a data CD.
 - b. Click on **New CD** to add another session to your CD.
 - c. Click on **Untitled CD** and give your session a name.



- d. Drag files to be recorded into the data window.
- e. Insert your CD-R or CD-RW into the recordable CD drive (use the eject button located on the upper right corner of your keyboard).
- f. Click on the **Record** button to begin burning another session.

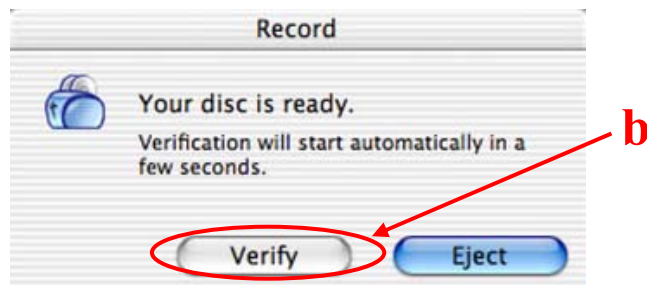


3. Record data onto CD:

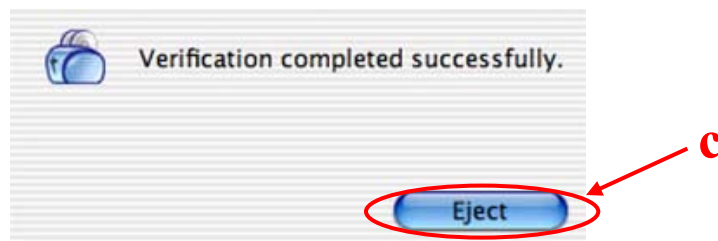
- a. Click on **Write Session** to record another session (Click on **Write Disc only** if you are certain that you will not be burning any more sessions onto the CD).



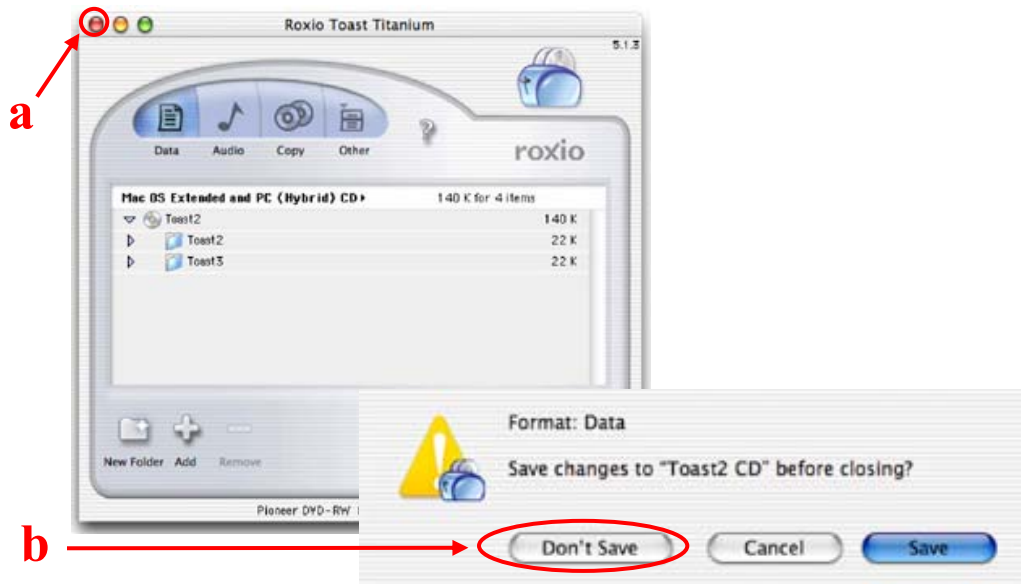
- b. When prompted, click on Verify (or wait a little while and verification will start automatically)



- c. Click on **Eject** to eject the CD.



4. Exit Toast application:
 - a. Click on the Close button or select Toast from the menu bar and click on Quit Toast.
 - b. When prompted to save, click on **Don't Save**.



5. View data on CD:
 - a. Insert CD into drive to confirm that you have recorded your data properly. You should be able to view all of the sessions that you have burned. One CD icon represents an individual session.



Burning a DVD

* Follow these instructions if you are burning data onto a DVD.

1. Launch Toast by double clicking the toast icon on the desktop (or by locating it on the hard drive in the application folder).

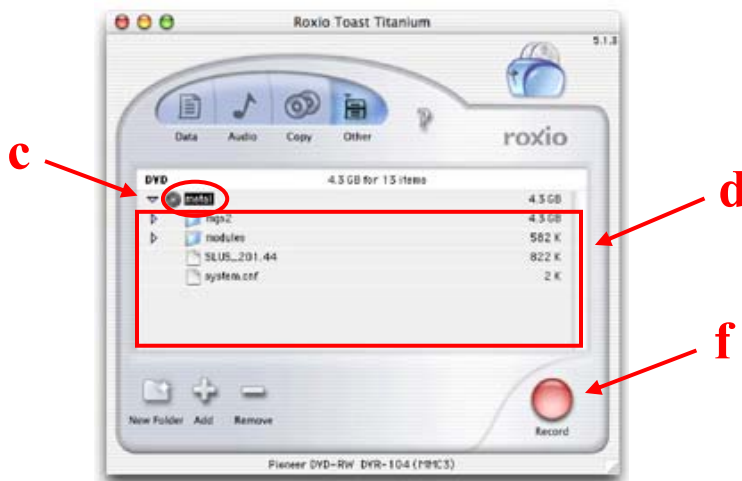


2. Prepare data for burning:

- a. Click on the **Other** tab and hold the mouse down for 2 seconds.
- b. Select **DVD** to burn data onto a DVD.

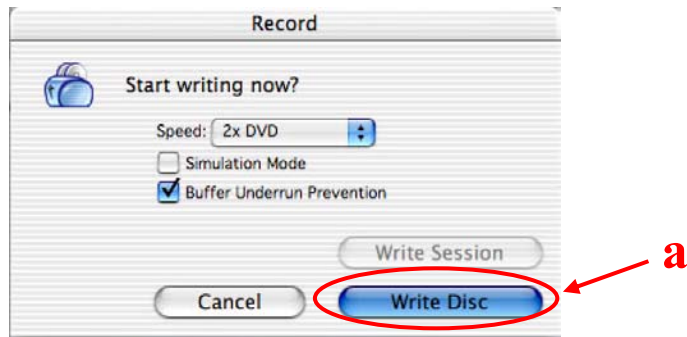


- c. Click on the **Untitled DVD** and give your session a name.
- d. Drag files to be recorded into the data window.
- e. Insert your DVD into the recordable CD/DVD drive (use the eject button located on the upper right corner of your keyboard).
- f. Click on the **Record** button to begin burning your files to DVD.

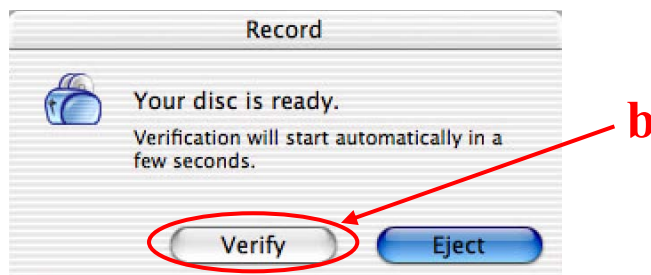


3. Record data onto DVD:

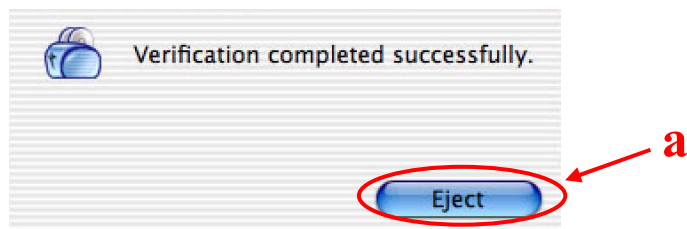
- a. Click on **Write Disc** to record data onto the DVD.



- b. When prompted, click on **Verify** (or wait a little while and verification will start automatically).



- c. Click on Eject to eject the DVD.



4. View data on DVD:

- a. Insert DVD into a DVD player to confirm that you have recorded your data properly.
